Information & Instructions

FSSA Scholarship Program

Any person is eligible to apply who is planning to enroll in a fire suppression technology program at an accredited two year or four year technical school, college, or university in North America. Previous winners are eligible for a second award, and must reapply each year to be considered.

Candidates must have sufficient academic records to be accepted by an accredited college, university, or technical institute. Students already in college are also eligible to apply.

Judges will take into consideration academic success, interest, special abilities, financial need, and other factors in arriving at their choice of scholarship recipients. The judges will give consideration to the degree in which the career choice could have an application to the fire suppression industry.

Instructions

The person applying for the scholarship must complete this application form and submit it online in ONE PDF document. It is recommended to submit the form as early as you can. FSSA should have the application, transcripts, and letters of recommendations by June 1. If you need more space to answer a question, use a blank piece of paper. Be sure your name appears on all attachments. This form may be reproduced. If you do not have a form, use plain paper.

In addition to this completed form, FSSA needs the following:

- A transcript of grades and credits, with the exception of the current semester. Students enrolled in college must furnish a copy of their high school transcripts and any other collegiate institutions attended.
- A letter of recommendation from an employer or other professional with whom you have worked.
- A letter of recommendation from a teacher, professor, or education professional.
- **These items MUST be submitted online on the FSSA website by June 1.**
